

## **2021 RUM RIVER HILLS LADIES LEAGUE MATCH PLAY (OPTIONAL)**

### **Match Play Eligibility:**

- You must have an established 18-hole handicap. Maximum allowable handicap for match play is capped at 44. If your handicap is higher than that, you may still enter, but the maximum of 44 will be used in this event.
- All players **MUST** be willing to play on the weekends to accommodate working members. If you cannot commit to a schedule such as this, please do not enter – it would not be fair to the rest of the participants.
- The first 32 ladies to sign up for this event will be allowed to participate. Once 32 participants have been signed up, further registrations will be closed.
- Entry fee is \$25.00 and will include your entry into a Consolation Bracket if eliminated in the first round. Be prepared for that.

### **Singles Match Play Notes**

- There will be two flights and pairings will be randomly drawn.
- Both players should make sure that they are using their current handicaps.
- Matches are to be played from the red markers unless both players agree to play from another set of tees.
- A normal match is 18 holes, but players may decide to play any number of holes to determine the winner.
- Players get 100% of their handicap up to a maximum of 44. Please use the red handicap ratings at the bottom of the score card to determine where your bumps fall.
- Flip a coin to determine which player tees off first.
- Determine how to handle a tie: sudden death, 9 extra holes, coin flip, score card play-off, etc.
- All league drop areas will be in play, according to league rules. .
- In the case of a rule in question. Play two balls and keep track of both scores. This may or may not affect the match. You can get a ruling from Jeff Tollette, or refer to a rules book.

NOTE: Any ruling that is agreed upon while playing during or after the round stands as is. This is a hole by hole event. Each hole is either WIN, LOSE, or DRAW. Once a hole is conceded this cannot be retracted. Once a putt is conceded if the player putts out and misses this is still considered a good putt for the match. If a player agrees at the time of play with a drop as an example, even if later they find out this drop was incorrect the agreement at time of play stands.

### **Scoring**

- Be sure to fill in a legible Singles Match Play scorecard containing names, scores, date, and signatures.
- Enter your own scores into the GHIN App, using hole-by-hole procedures. If you aren't sure how to do that, please ask and someone will help you.
- Once the final score of the match has been determined, the remaining hole-by-hole scores can be no worse than a net par (based on the player's 18-hole handicap), even if the round is not finished.
- Let Cindy Jorgenson know who won the match for updating brackets.
